# **Declaring 'no interest' in trees**



If a tree on your property is near power lines, and is either:

• Self-seeded or

• At the time of planting, you reasonably believed it wouldn't interfere with power lines when fully grown

Then you can declare 'no interest' in the tree. This means it will be trimmed or removed at Powerco's discretion

(or may not be worked on at all).

This is a request to treat the trees outlined in this notice as 'no interest' trees, under regulations 15 and 16 of the Electricity (Hazards From Trees) Regulations 2003 (the 'regulations').
